Through dynamic programming, professional mentorship, and hands-on challenges, LDP equips mid-career Rotaractors with the confidence, skills, and connections to grow as leaders—both personally and professionally.

Program Goals

Structure & Format

Touchpoints:

- 1 Local Retreat
- 7 Monthly Events (targeting the 2nd Wednesday of each month)
- Capstone Group Project
- 3 Misc Program Events

Program Format:

- **Workshops**: Interactive, skill-based sessions (e.g., public speaking, financial wellness, DISC leadership profiles)
- Panels: Cross-sector leadership panels featuring Birmingham's top professionals
- Capstone: Fellows collaborate on a real-world leadership challenge, presented to the Rotaract Board in April



Key Program Features

- Professional Partners: Each fellow is matched with a professional mentor for monthly 1:1 conversations
- **@ Hands-On Learning**: From communication to strategy to collaboration, fellows gain direct experience through workshops and group work
- Local Focus, Big Impact: Sessions spotlight Birmingham's industries, leaders, and opportunities

Eligibility Criteria

- Active member of the Rotaract Club of Birmingham
- Early-to-mid career professional with a demonstrated interest in leadership and community involvement
- Commitment to participate fully in all program activities. Failure to attend program events in-person will result in a meeting with program leadership
